

# Addendum to the General Purchasing Conditions of the Piepenbrock Group for the procurement of materials and services.

(Hastamat Verpackungstechnik GmbH + Co. KG)

Section 1 Ordering supplements section 3 clause 3.1., Section 2 Delivery deadlines and dates is an extension of section 7 clause 7.2, Section 3 Warranty and complaints is a note to section 10 clause 10.3.

#### 1 Ordering

As an alternative to our signed order, the Contractor may submit its own order confirmation. The order confirmation and its terms shall only apply to the relevant order and shall be agreed again for subsequent orders.

#### 2 Delivery deadlines and dates

The contractual penalties of 0.5% for each working day and the total contractual penalty of a maximum of 5% in accordance with section 7 clause 7.2 shall only apply if we and the Contractor have agreed to this in writing in advance. The written agreement must be attached to the relevant order. In the absence of a joint agreement, section 7 clause 7.2 shall not apply.

#### 3 Warranty and complaints

The warranty claims agreed between us and the Contractor shall apply.

These must be notified to us in writing for each order. The agreed claims shall apply to the respective execution of the work.

### 4 Environment, climate protection and sustainability

The Contractor must ensure that its production processes and products fully comply with all applicable environmental regulations.

The Contractor is encouraged to implement and maintain a certified environmental management system in accordance with ISO 14001 or comparable standards throughout the duration of the business relationship. The environmental management system should reasonably address topics such as hazardous substances, sustainable collaboration, water, waste, and air quality.

The Contractor is expected to develop appropriate corporate targets for its Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions and to take steps to support us in reducing  $CO_2$  emissions. The Contractor should regularly monitor its progress and, upon request, especially regarding its product-level  $CO_2$  footprint, provide reports.

The Contractor shall take suitable and reasonable measures to minimize the use and consumption of resources, particularly energy, water, and raw materials, both during production and in the products themselves, as well as throughout its own supply chain. The Contractor shall monitor and docu-
